


Family Activities in South Lake Tahoe Summer 2021

The Trail head is a 1 mile walk from the Edgewood Resort. A short walk from the Stateline, NV casinos, Van Sickle is one the most accessible parks in the Tahoe Basin. A short climb from the trailhead quickly transports visitors to the serenity of the forest. The park's easy to moderate trails are studded with rock outcroppings that present grand views of the largest alpine lake in North America and the surrounding peaks. The Rim Trail Connector provides a tie-in to the famed Tahoe Rim Trail, designated by National Geographic Adventure magazine as one of the nation's top ten trails. The park is open to hikers, bicyclists and equestrians.

This gravity-powered alpine coaster will exhilarate you and your family as it coasts through forest and natural rock formations. As always the views are incredible and the memories will be too! The coaster sleds fit up to two riders, so you can enjoy this activity with others. Pricing: Gondola and Coaster – Adult one ride: \$85, Senior/Teen one ride: \$73, Child one ride: \$58.




Nevada Beach Bicycle Cruise –

This is an ideal ride for the entire family on connected shared-used bike paths. There are two legs to this Loop: Lakeside and Mountain side and when connected provide a diverse and enjoyable ride. **The Lakeside**, clockwise direction, passes through Rabe Meadow and meanders through the forest accessing two great beaches: Nevada State Beach and Campground, and Round Hill Pines Resort and Beach. The second leg, **the Mountain side**, is accessible from either Elk Point Rd. or Pine Ridge Dr. Continuing clockwise from the beaches, ride toward Hwy 50 and Round Hill Shopping Center where you will cross Hwy 50 and just passed the gas station is a driveway where the bike path continues. This portion of the loop is through the forest with very few users and exits on Pine Ridge Dr. that continues on to Kingsbury Grade. At Kingsbury Grade, turn right and travel downhill to Hwy 50 and complete the Loop. Bicycle can be rented at [Shoreline Adventure Center](#) on Kahle Drive



Vikingsholm – Tahoe's hidden castle. vikingsholm.com Located in Emerald Bay is the historic Vikingsholm Castle. Vikingsholm is considered one of the finest examples of Scandinavian architecture in the United States. It is now a part of the Harvey West Unit of the Emerald Bay State Park. The house is open for tours during the summer months and the magnificent scenery may be enjoyed all year around by those wishing to visit this beautiful setting.



Sand Harbor, 30 minute drive from Edgewood, is one of the most popular and spectacular parks in the Tahoe basin. The park has many beaches for swimming, sunbathing and exploring. The Main Beach is 2,500 feet long and is popular for swimming and sunbathing and a wide variety of beach activities. There is also a small launch corridor for non-motorized watercraft at the south end (look for the buoys).



Tahoe Via Ferrata – [Tahoe Via Ferrata | Squaw Alpine](#) Located in Squaw Valley (1 hour drive from Edgewood Resort) Explore Squaw Valley's most iconic rock face, The Tram Face, on the all-new Via Ferrata routes operated by local guide service, Alpenglow Expeditions. Learn to navigate the rock face on the protected climbing route with permanent steel anchors and cables that keep participants safely connected to the rock 100% of the time.
